There has been a lot of de-rusting around the body and frame. Bill has been busy in the cab cleaning under the control panel which at the moment is still ongoing.

At the days end, with consultation with Bill, I have suggested that I will look into the air resivior drainage which is discharged over one the driving wheels. This will be brought to the outer edge of the running board. The drainage of oil from the compressors will also be brought out under the running board. Next task will look at the air cleaner of the compressors.

The job completed today was Noel and I de-rusted where the battery boxes are to be sited. Between Bill and Carl these sites have been painted.
